Maths

In Maths we will be working on fractions again and learning about finding fractions of amounts, We will remind children of their division knowledge and work with them to understand how to find a half and a quarter of an amount.

English

The children will plan their stories and then write them using all of the knowledge they have learnt this year.

Reading

Topic

History - In History we will be learning about the life and work of the famous Victorians Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole.

PSHE - In PSHE we will be thinking about how we can show our friends and family that we care about them. In computing we will be finishing off our coding using all the skills that we have learned this half term.

Science - In Science we will be planting a cress. We will then send this home so the children can watch the changes over the next week.

Music - This week we will be performing our song, Use Your Imagination with percussion instruments

Art - This week we will be sketching the animals that inspired the Beatrix Potter tales.

RE - In RE this week we will be thinking about the things that Christians believe God created.

Please look at the alien and real word sheet and practise reading each word aloud.

When reading an alien word the children can pronounce the trigraphs and digraphs in any way they have learnt. For example the digraph 'ea' could be pronounced as it is in the words bread or beat. Please show your teachers that you have had a look at your words by ticking or circling them.

As well as practising the phonics words please continue to read 4 times a week.
