# We hope that you all have a lovely half term break and look forward to seeing the children back at school on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> June.

#### Maths

In Maths we will be learning about position and direction. We will be describing the position of objects and using the words left and right. We will also be using words such as next to, above, below, forwards and backwards. We will be giving instructions to each other and following instructions to help us move an object across a grid and find the treasure. Added to this we will be learning about turns and making whole,  $\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $\frac{1}{4}$  and  $\frac{3}{4}$  turns.

#### English

In English this week we will be thinking about the upcoming Platinum Jubilee celebrations. We will be celebrating the Queen's life and learning about some of the historical events that have taken place during her reign.

We will then be writing sentences to describe what we would do if we were King/ Queen for the day.

We will also be thinking about descriptive language and writing and advert to help Queen Elizabeth sell Buckingham Palace!

Reading

The children will be reading 1:1 with an adult. Please ensure your child has their book and reading record at school every day.

#### **Phonics**

This week each child will participate in the Phonics Screening Check. Each child will carry out the test 1:1 with their class teacher. It will be a similar experience to their practise test, which took place at the beginning of the term. We will ensure that each child knows this is an opportunity to show off how hard they have been working on their sounds and not something to feel worried about.
