# Learning in school:

# Topic: Minibeasts and Growth

This next half term we will be learning about the different stages of plant and animal growth. We will be finding out about a variety of minibeasts and looking at similarities and differences between them and where we find them.

Our minibeast focus for this week will be 'the bee'. We will be learning facts about the insect and making honey. We will then re-order, read and follow instructions to make our own honey sandwiches! Please update your child's class teacher if your child has any new allergies!

### Phonics:

This week we will be reading and writing words with the suffixes: 'ing', 'ed' and 'est'for example: snapping, grunted and strongest. Our new tricky words will be: out and today.

#### Maths:

In Maths we will continue to consolidate our learning about taking away. We will be using practical resources and working on accuracy; as well as completing number calculations. Alongside this, we will also be using number lines to count forwards and backwards from different stating points.
