### **Maths**

#### **Learning in school:**

Next week we will be continuing our measurement topic.

At the beginning of the week we will be investigating the weight of different objects around the classroom and using the language, heavier, lighter and equal, when comparing different objects to each other.

We will also be starting to look at time. We will be learning how the clock works, thinking about the importance of each hand and telling time to the hour. At the end of the week we will be looking at half past times.
