Learning in school:

Theme for the Term: A journey back in time!

We're starting a new topic. The children have shown a great interest in dinosaurs in class so we're going on a journey back in time to widen our knowledge about dinosaurs. We will be looking at the similarities and differences between the dinosaurs, their size and features. Throughout the term, we will be continuing to practise name writing and will introduce the children to writing simple CVC words (e.g. pen) and short sentences. During music, we will be making dinosaur music, thinking about how we can change the sounds of the instruments for big/small/scary and gentle dinosaurs.

Theme for the week: Dig! Dig! Dig!

We will be starting the week with an exciting visit from an archaeologist who will be bringing in some real dinosaur fossil for us to excavate. Please don't tell your children about this as it is a surprise. We'll also be reading the story Dinosaurs Roar! Throughout the week, we will be practising using the new vocabulary from the book: Squeak, Meek, Weak, Spikey, Lumpy, Nibble and Munch.

Phonics:

This week in school, we will begin to learn the letter sounds ck, e, u and r.

Maths:

This week, we will be working on counting and representing the numbers 1, 2 and 3. We will also be working on our number formation.

All children will have taken home a reading book to share at home. Please don't forget to log any comments on the Go-Read app. It is good practise for children to practise a

book a couple of times before changing it. When you would like the book changed please send your child to school with it in their hand so that we can change it first thing. Thank you
