Learning in school

Maths

Learning in school:

This week we will be adding one and two digit numbers together by counting on. We will be using a variety of resources to practise this as well as learning how to use a number line. The children will be encouraged to think about addition being commutative when deciding which number to count on from. We will also reinforce number bonds to 10 and look at how we can use this knowledge to help us know the number bonds to 20. We will be adding a ten to different numbers and reinforcing our work on place value.

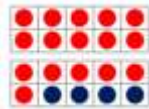
For example: $7+3=10$ $17+3=20$

We will be using tens frames to explore the bonds of 10 and 20

$$6+4=10$$



$$16+4=20$$



English

Learning in school:

This week we will be continuing our learning, thinking about the story "Stuck," by Oliver Jeffers. We will be sequencing the story and looking at the order that some of the objects got stuck in the tree. We will then try to retell the story in our own words, remembering to add good expression so as to make our stories sound interesting to our partners. We will then be writing questions to ask Floyd the main character in the story. We will continue to practise writing in full sentences, remembering capital letters, finger spaces and question marks.

We also be concentrating on adding adjectives and time sentence openers to our writing.

Phonics

Learning in school:

Next week we will be thinking about the new digraphs *oe*, *y* (igh) *ow*, *g* (j).

We will be reading the words: hairy, boulder, grew, spread, breakfast, goes, smelly, spy, reply, paper. True, woe, carry, dry, snow, show, shaking, amaze.

We will be thinking about the following tricky words: again, who, whole and where

Topic

Learning in school:

Next week in Art we will be introducing a new artist, Andy Warhol. We will be looking at his work and creating our own pastel versions of one of his pieces.

In PE we will be continuing our units in dance and ball skills.

In computing we will be thinking more about e-safety.

The term's topic is Up, up and away and a focus of our learning will be famous events and people within history. Next week we will be learning about the history of kites.

In science we will be thinking more about the properties of different materials.
