Learning in school:

Theme for the Term: Tell us a story

During this topic we will be exploring stories about journeys, real and imagined, with a particular focus on the story, On the Way Home by Jill Murphy. We will be looking at different types of journeys with a focus on writing and using adjectives to describe the journey.

Theme for the Week: On the way home!

This week we will be sharing what we found on our journeys during the holidays. The children will be talking about their journeys, showing their photos, describing the journey and what they found using full sentences and adjectives.

We will be going on a journey for Field Friday! The children will need their wellies. There will be lots of exciting things for the children to find as we explore the field.

We will also be recapping 'What would Roo Do?' to help solve our own small social problems, role playing scenarios and making suggestions on what a good choice or action would be.

Phonics:

This week we will be recapping the digraphs we have learned previously (qu, ch, sh, th, ng, nk) and learning the new digraphs ai, ee and oa as well as our first trigraph igh. We will send out sounds sheet the first week back.

Maths:

This week we are focussing on the composition of 4 and 5. We will be using songs, fives frames and equipment to enhance the children's understanding.

Homework for the holidays will be to have fun, play games, and enjoy time with your family!

Please note that we will not be listening to readers during the first week back. We will be concentrating on settling the children back into school and getting used to the routine again. Your child can change their book any day.
