Learning in school:

Theme for the Term: Tell us a story

During this topic we will be exploring stories about journeys, real and imagined, with a particular focus on the story, On the Way Home by Jill Murphy. We will be looking at different types of journeys with a focus on writing and using adjectives to describe the journey.

Theme for the Week: Where The Wild Things Are!

This week we will be focusing on character descriptions through our focus story of 'Where The Wild Things Are'. We will be reading the story and using adjectives to describe the 'Wild Things'. We will also be creating our own mini-monsters to join the Wild Things.

Phonics:

This week we will be recapping the digraphs and trigraphs we have learned previously (qu, ch, sh, th, ng, nk, ai, ee, igh, oa) and learning the new digraphs oo(look), oo(moon), ar and or.

Maths:

This week we will be continuing with our number bond work and using the vocabulary of 'part' and 'whole'. We will be working on recalling number bond facts to 5 without counting. (through memory / subitising)
