Learning in school:

Theme for the Term: Celebrations! Everyone enjoys a celebration and there are so many across a year. We will dip into a few to find out what is celebrated and how the occasion is marked.

Theme for the week: Autumn!

We will start the week wearing odd socks for Anti-Bullying week. We will be celebrating our differences and learning to be kind to each other. During the week, we will be reading the story 'The Leaf Thief' and looking at the changes that Autumn brings. The children will be looking for signs of a "leaf thief" on our school field and making leaves for the squirrel.

Phonics:

This week in school, we will be learning the grapheme v, w, x and y. We will continue practising blending and start to write some 3 letter words.

Maths:

This week, we will be learning all about circles and triangles. This will include going on a shape hunt and creating our own artwork using circles
and shapes, based on the artist Kandinsky. We will be learning about their
properties using the terminology corners and sides.
