Coming up next week...14.11.22

Maths

This week in school we will be continuing our work on addition. We will be learning about different methods which help us find the difference and practising identifying the right resources to help us solve addition calculations and word problems.

English

This week we will be continuing to think about our story, 'Lost in the toy museum.' We will be rehearsing the story and thinking about elements of the story that we could change. We will also be creating word and phrase banks using our adjective knowledge.

Reading

We will be introducing our new bug club story, 'Lost in the Storm.' We will be thinking about the following words in these sessions: mountain, valley, coast, beach, sea, shore, cliff, forest, hill, river, cave, lightning, thunder, frightening, adventure.

If you have an opportunity please discuss the words with your child to help embed it into their vocabulary.

Please remember that at The Mead we encourage the children to read to you at least four times each week as they really benefit from practising their reading regularly at home. Please continue to send books in daily and remember students can change them every day.

Phonics

Next week we will be introducing the sounds a-e, i-e, o-e, u-e. We will be thinking about the tricky words: Mr, Mrs, Ms, ask, could, would, should and our.

Science - In Science we will be looking at different materials and their properties

History - As part of our topic learning we will be thinking about old and modern toys and using our knowledge of timelines to place them in chronological order.

PE - We will be continuing our new topics of fundamentals and ball skills.

Music - We will be thinking about pitch and rhythm through our new unit.

Computing - We will be starting our new Purple Mash unit Grouping and Sorting.
