# Coming up after next week... 06.03.23

## Maths

This week, the children will be continuing their learning of place value to 50. We will be looking at number lines and discussing that the starting and ending number can be different. We will look at number lines that have intervals counting in 1s and 10s. The children will then be using this knowledge to estimate where a given number might be on a number line.

# **English**

Next week we will be reading a new story the 'Midnight Gardener.' The children will be learning about postcards and writing one from the main character's point of view.

# Reading

Next week we will be continuing our story The Artist.

We will be answering comprehension question based on the learning we have done so far. We will also be trying to use the new vocabulary we have learned in sentences.

## **Topic**

PSHCE: Next week we will be thinking about what makes us different from each other. We will be talking about the terms respect and tolerance; and considering how we can show each other those things.

Art: In Art we will be creating a piece of work by using water colour paints. We will be using our knowledge of mixing colours to create different shades.

Computing: We will be continuing our new topic and creating our animated stories.

Science: Next week we will be thinking about different types of plants PE: We will be continuing our new units, gymnastics and sending and receiving.

Geography: In Geography we will be consolidating our knowledge of the oceans and continents and working with our friends to answer questions in a team.
