Yr Two Antarctica Workshop

Dear Parents / Carers,

On Thursday 9th February, in lieu of the cancelled Great Fire of London workshop, we are pleased to be able to welcome Freshwater Theatre to facilitate an Antarctica workshop. We hope that this workshop will enhance and consolidate the children's current learning about the Poles.

The children will be greeted by an intrepid Earth Explorer who will invite them on an adventure to Antarctica. Using drama activities such as roleplay and tableaux, they will explore the topic in an engaging and interactive way. They will consider what it is to be an explorer whilst readying themselves (mentally and physically!) for an expedition like no other. Once there, they will explore the habitat, meet some of the wildlife and learn what's threatening this landscape and why it needs to be protected. There may even be a chance to travel further...not through space, but through time, back to 1901 to meet the explorers' first charting their way across the Antarctic.
