## Learning in school:

Topic: Let's explore our planet

This half term we will learning about our planet. We will be looking at our local environment, and then comparing, and contrasting our local environment with other countries.

This week we will be coming back from half term to find that a suitcase has been left in our classrooms. We will be describing the suitcase and drawing whom we think the suitcase belongs to. We will also be sharing part of the book 'Lost and Found' and working on the reading skill prediction.

#### Phonics:

This week we will be focusing on words with short vowel sounds. We will be reading and writing CVCC words, for example went, help, thump, tenth.

Maths:

In Maths we will be learning numbers beyond 10 and looking at the pattern of ten and how many ones.
