### **Maths**

#### **Learning in school:**

In maths, children will continue their learning on multiplication and division.

- Doubling and halving
- Odd and even numbers
- The ten times table
- Divide by 10

### **English**

#### **Learning in school:**

In English, children will be continuing to focus on the story 'Journey'. They will be learning about different sentence types: statements, exclamations, questions and commands and linking these sentence types to illustrations from the book.

### **Phonics/ SPAG**

#### **Learning in school:**

Phonics: Children will be reviewing Phase 5 phonemes, graphemes and tricky words. They will practise reading, writing and spelling using these graphemes.

SPAG: Children will be learning to spell words beginning with kn, gn and wr.

### **Topic**

#### **Learning in school:**

**History:** This week we will compare and contrast Ibn Battuta's experiences with those of other explorers.

**RE:** Children will be continuing their learning about Islam. Children will think about the important question - how can we tell if something is important for a Muslim family? This week we will focus on Eid.

**PSHE:** Children will continue the module 'Rights and Respect'

**Music:** Children will be starting a new unit, focussed on Africa.

**Computing:** It is e-safety day on Tuesday so children will be learning about how to stay safe online.

**PE:** On Friday we hope to finish off our gymnastics module by using the equipment in the hall. Across all 3 classes, please could you make sure that your child is dressed in clothes that will be easy for them to move in/ safe for PE on Friday. Many thanks.
