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Coming up next week... 10.02.25

Maths

In Maths we will be looking at subtraction. We will practise counting back and explore 'counting up' to find the difference. We will be looking at the skills required to answer missing number problems. We will think carefully about whether a part is missing or a whole is missing. We will apply our skills of subtraction and addition to find the missing numbers. Then we will be revisiting fact families and finding all related facts when working with numbers within 20.

English

In English, the children will revisit what adjectives and nouns are and why they are used in writing. We will use our plans to write a setting description. We will be practising the skill of re-reading what we have already written to check that it makes sense and to help us correct errors.

Phonics and Reading

There won't be any new graphemes this week as we consolidate all the phonemes covered this half term. Each class will focus on their own identified set of trickiest sounds for them. They will be identifying the graphemes individually as well as spotting them and blending them in real and 'alien' (pseudo) words. We will also be reading 1:1 so please make sure your child's reading book is in their bag. We will also be practising fluency with the AI generated poem: Feelings journey.

Topic

PSHE - We will gently explore the feelings associated with loss. Sometimes we lose things and find them again and sometimes we lose things forever. We will acknowledge that feeling sad is acceptable and we'll talk about things that might help to make people feel better and identify that different things suit different people.

RE- This week, the children will be presenting their learning all about the Jewish special book. The children will choose a method to share their learning about the Torah and why it is important to Jewish people.

PE- In PE we will continue with our Pirate dance focusing on the use of clear actions and expression to tell a story.

Computing -We will be celebrating 'safer internet day' on Tuesday 11th February.

Science- We will concluding our animals topic by learning about the scientist Jane Goodall. We will find out about some of her findings and the science skill of observing over time.

Design & Technology- Once all of the puppets have been joined together, the children will be exploring how to decorate their puppets, following their design plan. They will add the last details and features, showing the character they have made.

Music - The children will be performing, demonstrating their understanding of their musical learning this term.
