Maths

Learning in school:

In maths, children will be continuum 'position and direction'.

The children will be exploring the language related to position and movement. This will include the difference between clockwise and anti-clockwise, quarter, half and full turns.

English, Reading & Fluency

Learning in school:

In English, children will be continuing their chapter books and editing. They will set a personal target to improve their writing and use this target when they are writing their next chapter.

Reading:

In Year 2 we use 'Bug Club' to teach reading. Children use the knowledge they have gained in their SPAG sessions to decode words alongside their teacher and peers. The stories we read span over a two-week period and throughout this time we focus on different VIPERs - vocabulary, inference, prediction, retrieval and sequence. As well as using role play and storytelling to promote a love of reading.

We will be hearing the children read individually over the next few weeks and using VIPERS questions to support comprehension skills.

Fluency:

This week, we will be looking at a poem called 'My Treasures Please continue to read at home and upload your comments onto the 'BoomReader' app.

SPAG

Learning in school:

Children will be reviewing Phase 5 phonemes, graphemes and tricky words. They will practise reading, writing and spelling using these graphemes.

Topic

Learning in school:

Science: From plants to products - children will continue to explore suitability of materials.

Geography: Children will continue to explore the oceans and learn facts about them.

RE: Children will exploring how non-religious people give and help their community.

D&T: Children will continue their module called 'textiles'.

PSHE: Children will continue their module 'Growing and changing'.

Music: Children will continue their music module for this half term, which is called 'Musical Me'.

Computing: Children will begin their computing module called 'Coding'.

PE: For this half term, the children will be doing 'Invasion'.
