Maths

Learning in school:

In maths, children will continue their learning about shape.

- Counting faces, edges and vertices on 3D shapes
- Sorting 3D shapes
- Making patterns with 2D and 3D shapes

English, Reading & Fluency

Learning in school:

In English, children will be starting to look at poetry. We will be focusing on alliteration and onomatopoeia.

Reading:

It is individual reads this week so please make sure your child's book is in their book bag.

Fluency:

This week, we will look at a poem called 'Rhythm of Life' by Michael Rosen.

Please continue to read at home and upload your comments onto the 'BoomReader' app.

SPAG

Learning in school:

Children will be reviewing Phase 5 phonemes, graphemes and tricky words. They will practise reading, writing and spelling using these graphemes.

Topic

Learning in school:

History: Children will be learning about journeys and comparing the journeys that some famous explorers took.

RE: Children will be learning about Islam. Children will think about the important questions - what is a family and what could they be doing together? How do we show what is important to us?

Science: Children will be learning about the human lifecycle.

PSHE: Children will begin the module 'Keeping myself safe.'

D&T: Children will begin their module 'Sculpture - Baby Bear's chair'.

Music: Children will begin their music module for this half term, which is called 'Contrasting dynamics'.

Computing: Children will begin their computing module 'Presenting Ideas'.
