Maths

Our fractions unit continues this week, exploring quarters. We will be finding quarters of shapes and quantities.

MATHS HOMEWORK: At home can you find objects around your house (e.g. pens, dry pasta shapes, Lego bricks). Count how many you have and find half. How many are in each group? Are they equal? Can you challenge yourself to find a quarter?

English

This week the children will start to write their instructions. We will be focussing on the key features: time words and 'bossy' verbs and adjectives and adverbs to add detail.

Phonics and Reading

We are revising the graphemes:

'i' in tiger

'a' paper

'ow' snow

'u' unicorn

We will be revising the tricky words: **two, eye, thought, through, friend.**

Our fluency text will be an extract from 'The Snail and the Whale' by Julia Donaldson.

Topic

History- This week we will be comparing early flight to present flight. We will be exploring and analysing resources to help us answer the question: How has flight changed since the Wright Brothers?

Art- Thank you for all the shoe boxes! This week the children will be working in pairs, to make their box into a loom by wrapping it in string. They will then create a piece of woven art by weaving wool and ribbon through it and attaching plaits and knotted material.

PSHE- We will be learning how Harold learns to ride his bike. We will recognise that learning a new skill requires practice and the understanding that you need the ability to overcome challenges.

Music- For our final session in this unit, we will be performing our superhero theme tunes.
