Maths

In Maths this week we will continue with our learning about time. We will be learning about the difference between hours, minutes, and seconds. We will then move on to reading o'clock and half past times on the analogue clock.

Maths Homework

Look at an analogue clock. Discuss the order of the numbers and point out that there are 12 because there are two 12 hour periods in a 24 hour day. Identify o'clock times throughout the day. They should start to recognise that when the minute hand is pointing directly to 12, they need to look at the shorter hour hand to see which hour it is.

English

To develop the next part of our fables, we will be exploring noun phrases (e.g. my dog/some tables) and expanded noun phrases (e.g. a dark sky/ those happy children) to help make our writing more interesting.

Topic

Geography – We will be learning about physical and natural features of Wales this week and comparing them to England and Scotland.

Music - the children will be learning to interpret symbols to demonstrate a pitch pattern.

Computing - We will be learning to find and understand examples of where technology is used in the local community.

PE- We will be continuing our learning in the units: target games and athletics.
