Maths

In Maths this week we will be learning about time. We will explore using different vocabulary related to time throughout the week. First, we will describe our own routine and use "before", "after", "first", "next" and "finally" to describe, sort and order events. We will learn the sequence of the days in a week and know that there are 7 days that repeat in a cycle. We will then explore the sequence of the months of the year and begin to learn the number of days in each month

Maths Homework

Have a look at a calendar. Start with looking at one week. How many days are there? When are the children at school? When are adults at work? Is there anything that happens repeatedly, on the same day of the week? Then look at the months of the year. How many are there? What are the names of them? Practise saying the order they come in. Which month would be before or after a given month? When do people in your family have birthdays? How many days are there in these months?

English

Now our moral has been chosen, we know the characters in our story, the setting and planned how the lesson will be learnt ... it's time to start the writing of our own fable.

Topic

Geography- This week we will be learning about physical and human features of England.

Science- Following sharing The Gruffalo by Julia Donaldson, we will be zoologists and go on a Gruffalo hunt. We will be recapping on our knowledge of animal features and using our science skills to observe, measure and record animal footprints.

RE - We will be exploring the question: How can we care for the world we all share?

Music - This week, we will be learning about pitch and rhythm.

PSHE- This week Milo will be helping us identify the difference between spending and saving.

PE- Due to Sports day we will only be having one additional PE lesson. This lesson will be on Wednesday for Badgers and Hedgehogs. Squirrels PE will be on Friday.
