#### Maths

### Learning in school:

In maths, children will be starting a new maths topic 'position and direction'.

The children will be exploring the language related to position and movement. This will include the difference between clockwise and anti-clockwise.

# English, Reading & Fluency

# Learning in school:

In English, children will continue writing chapter 2 and begin writing chapter 3 of their story. Chapter 3 will focus on conjunctions and using speech marks in their writing.

# Reading:

In Year 2 we use 'Bug Club' to teach reading. Children use the knowledge they have gained in their SPAG sessions to decode words alongside their teacher and peers. The stories we read span over a two-week period and throughout this time we focus on different VIPERs - vocabulary, inference, prediction, retrieval and sequence. As well as using role play and storytelling to promote a love of reading.

We will be hearing the children read individually over the next few weeks and using VIPERS questions to support comprehension skills.

#### Fluency:

This week, we will be looking at a poem called 'My Treasures

#### Learning in school:

Children will be reviewing Phase 5 phonemes, graphemes and tricky words. They will practise reading, writing and spelling using these graphemes.
