<u>Maths</u>

This week will conclude our learning on addition and subtraction. They will explore adding 1 or 2 in a variety of different contexts. They combine all the methods and approaches they have seen so far in this block. However, for the first time, they will need to decide whether they are being asked to add or subtract. Then we will start our new topic: geometry. Here the children will be learning about 3D shape. They will be identifying and naming the 3D shapes: cube, cuboid, sphere, pyramid, cone and cylinder and using the vocabulary: faces, curved and flat when they describe 3D shape properties.

English

We will be helping Father Christmas explain rhyme to his elves by recognising rhyming pairs and then generating their own rhyming strings. In addition to this we will be practising our list writing and revising the 's' and 'es' plural rule.

Phonics

Now the children have been taught many alternative graphemes, this week we will introduce them to the term 'grow the code'. For example we now know the /ee/ sound can be made in these additional ways: e (me), ea (beach), ie (belief), e-e (these).

We will also 'grow the code' for:

/ai/ a, ay, a-e

/oa/ o-e, o

/igh/ ie, i, i-e

/oo/ ew, ue, u, u-e

Also this week we will be revising all the tricky words we have covered so far.

Reading

We will continue to work on our Bug Club text: The Artist by Joseph Coelho. We will be exploring a range of art related vocabulary for example: technique, brushstrokes, foreground, background and middle ground as well as answering a range of different question styles. Our focus in fluency this week will be 'pace'. The children will be learning and performing: Five Little Reindeer

Topic

As we start to rehearse for our Christmas show, our next RE learning will be about who visited Baby Jesus and why they were important people.

In History we will be continuing our topic by finding out how food was packaged and stored.

We are going to cover our next DT unit in a block before the end of term. We will learning about wheels and axles. Please can we have boxes donated (no larger than a cereal box) for our vehicle making in DT the week beginning 9th December.

In Art our next painting objective will be to explore different shades of a secondary colour by mixing 2 primary colours.
