Maths
Learning in school: In maths, children will be consolidating their learning with some fun mathematical games and activities. We will be completing a data handling game using our knowledge of tally charts.
English, Reading & Fluency
Learning in school: In English, we will be finishing our chapter books and publishing them! We are very excited to share them with our friends.
Reading:
In Year 2 we use 'Bug Club' to teach reading. Children use the knowledge they have gained in their SPAG sessions to decode words alongside their teacher and peers. The stories we read span over a two-week period and throughout this time we focus on different VIPERs – vocabulary, inference, prediction, retrieval and sequence. As well as using role play and storytelling to promote a love of reading.
We will be hearing the children read individually over the next few weeks and using VIPERS questions to support comprehension skills.
SPAG
Learning in school:
Children will be reviewing Phase 5 phonemes, graphemes and tricky words. They will practise reading, writing and spelling using these graphemes.
