Maths

Learning in school:

In maths, children will begin their learning about time:

- > Children to make a clock
- > Tell the time past the hour
- > O'clock and half past
- > Quarter past and quarter to

English, Reading & Fluency

Learning in school:

In English, the children will write their final part of the story and explore speech and speech marks. Children will be publishing their books and putting them into the school library. Children will then evaluate their books and decide on a writing target for next term.

Reading:

Children will be starting their chapter book key text for English. Children will be looking at key features of a chapter book, looking for craft moves within a text (similes, adverbs, sentence types). Children will be creating their own story map based on the book 'Nelly Choc Ice Penguin Explorer'.

Fluency:

This week, we will be looking at a poem called 'How to turn your teacher purple'.

Learning in school:

Children will be reviewing Phase 5 phonemes, graphemes and tricky words. They will practise reading, writing and spelling using these graphemes.

Topic

Learning in school:

RE: Children will be learning about why it might be important for some Muslims to meet at the mosque to pray together on a Friday.

Science: Children will be learning about the lifecycle of a plant.
