Maths

Learning in school:

In maths, children will begin learning about multiplication:

- Recognising equal groups
- Make and add equal groups
- Introduce the multiplication symbol
- Multiplication sentences

Learning in school:

In English, children will be looking at performance poetry and will perform their own chosen poem.

Reading:

Learning in school:

Learning in school:
