## English, Reading & Fluency

## Learning in school:

In English, children will continue to write their non-fiction text. The children will be using a checklist to focus on conjunctions, the layout of the text and different punctuation. Children will also be introduced to 'Exclamation sentences' and they will add this to their non-fiction text.

## Reading:

In Year 2 we use 'Bug Club' to teach reading. Children use the knowledge they have gained in their SPAG sessions to decode words alongside their teacher and peers. The stories we read span over a two-week period and throughout this time we focus on different VIPERs - vocabulary, inference, prediction, retrieval and sequence. As well as using role play and storytelling to promote a love of reading.

This week the children will focus on all of the Vipers skills: vocabulary, inference, prediction, explain, retrieval and sequencing.

This daily shared reading approach has replaced the 1:1 reads. We will use this knowledge combined with phonics assessments and half termly 1:1 reads to inform our tracking of progression in reading and the children will still progress through the phases.

## Fluency:

This week, we will look at a poem called 'Air'.
