## **Maths**

### **Learning in school:**

In maths, children will continue their learning about Mass, capacity and temperature:

- Temperature

## **English, Reading & Fluency**

### **Learning in school:**

In English, the children will continue to make additions, revisions and corrections to their non-fiction writing using a bookmark checklist. They will also learn about command sentences and that these are used to give orders and instructions.

### **Reading:**

### **Learning in school:**

Children will be reviewing Phase 5 phonemes, graphemes and tricky words. They will practise reading, writing and spelling using these graphemes.

## **Topic**

### **Learning in school:**

**Geography:** Children will be comparing an aerial view of Stoneleigh to an aerial view of a school in rural Malawi. Children will be observing and writing a comparison of the differences.

**RE:** Children will design their Easter Garden.

**Science:** Children will be learning about how animals and plants depend on each other in a Rainforest and Ocean habitats.

**Art:** Children will continue their module called 'Craft and Design: Map it out'.

**PSHE:** Children will continue their new module 'Rights and Responsibilities'.

**Music:** Children will continue their music module for this half term, which is called 'Singing: on this Island'.

**Computing:** Children will continue their computing module 'Spreadsheets'.

**PE:** For this half term, the children will be doing Sending and Receiving.
