Learning in school:

Topic: Far, Far Away...

This half term we will be learning about our planet. We will be looking at our local environment, and then comparing, and contrasting our local environment with other countries.

This week, be continuing our transition project, 'All About Me.' The children have been busy writing and illustrating their books and they are looking fantastic! The children will be sharing their books with others in groups.

We are going to be working on Listening and Attention skills using games and fun activities, as well as supporting transition through stories such as A Little Bit Brave.

As part DT, the children will be working on designing their own boats. We have previously explored floating and sinking so the children will need to use this knowledge to help design a boat that floats.

Phonics:

This week, the children will be taking part in Phonics Assessments. In the classroom, they will be recapping all the Phase 2, 3 and 4 sounds and tricky words.

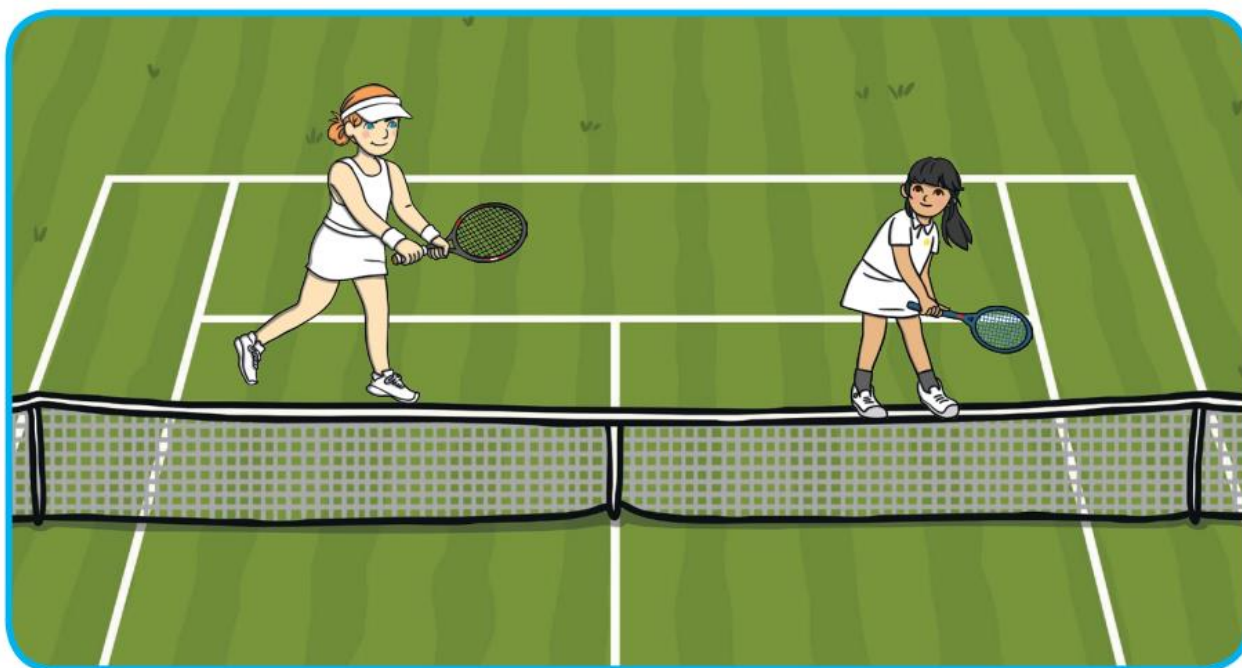
Maths:
