## Learning in school:

Theme for the Term: Fabulous Festivals!

During this topic we will learning about how people and communities celebrate in different ways and why this is important to them.

Theme for the week: This week we will look at what Diwali is and how people celebrate it. We will look at photos and objects and read the story of Rama and Sita. We are also looking at the importance of the charity Child in Need, what it means to be kind and how we can express kindness to others.

#### **Phonics**

This week, we will be learning the sounds v, x, w, y. Our tricky words are 'and, his, has, her' and we are recapping 'the, put, pull, full'.

#### Maths:

This week we will be learning about the one more and one less and then the composition of 1, 2 and 3. The children need to understand that whole number and its parts so we will be introducing this to them.
