Coming up next week...15/9/2025

Maths

In Maths we will be counting backwards. We will be using the term 'value' and discussing how the numbers become lower in value when you count back. We will also be using the term 'less' and using a number track to help us calculate one less than a given number.

<u>English</u>

We are continuing our exciting journey into creating our own storybooks! This week, the children will be focusing on three key elements of storytelling: the **character**, the **setting**, and what the **character** is **doing**. To spark their imaginations, we'll be using some playful "story maths" – a fun way to combine two different ideas to invent a new story. For example, *dinosaur* + *pizza* might become a story about a dinosaur delivering pizza! This creative approach helps children explore how simple ideas can be combined to build engaging and original stories.

Phonics

Next week we will be recapping 'air' and 'er' and reading words with 2 or more digraphs e.g. qu-ee-n, t-ee-th. We will also be looking at the tricky words: What when he she we be me have love.

Reading

This week will be beginning our shared reading as a whole class. Our Bug Club story is called: Idris and the Big City. We will spend the week reading the story with a focus on prediction and vocabulary.

Your child should now have a phased reading book in their bookbag. They can read it over a number of days and even read it more than once. Please record any reading you do in the yellow reading record. When they are ready to change it, please can they have it in their hand when they arrive at the classroom door so we can direct them to the reading train. They can do so every day if they wish!

Topic

In Art we will be learning about the artist Bridget Riley. We will be exploring the way she uses different types of lines: wavy, crosshatch, diagonal, vertical, horizontal and creating our own lined image.

In Geography we will continue our learning about aerial view. After a walk around the school, the children will be drawing their own maps.

In RE we will be explore the question: I wonder why God gave in creation?

In science the children will be discovering events and activities that take place in the four seasons and suggesting appropriate clothing to wear in different weather conditions.
