Maths

Learning in school:

In maths, children will continue their learning on money:

English, Reading & Fluency

Learning in school:

In English, the children will continue to develop their story plans for their Claude books. They will also look at the features of a character description and write their own character description based on a character in their story. The children will then look at what makes a great story opener and work on their own opening of their story.
