### **Maths**

#### **Learning in school:**

In maths, children will begin their learning on length and height:

- Measure in centimetres
- Measure in metres
- Compare lengths and heights
- Order lengths and heights

### **English, Reading & Fluency**

#### **Learning in school:**

In English, children will continue to write their non-fiction text focusing on conjunctions and using a possessive apostrophe.

#### **Guided Reading:**

Children will read 'We found a hat'. Children will be focusing on the VIPERS: inference.

#### **Fluency:**

This week, we will look at a poem called 'Air' by Michael Rosen.

**Please continue to read at home and record it in the yellow 'Home Reading Diary'.**

### **SPAG**

#### **Learning in school:**

Children will be reviewing Phase 5 phonemes, graphemes and tricky words. They will practise reading, writing and spelling using these graphemes.

### **Topic**

#### **Learning in school:**

**Geography:** Children will be learning where Malawi is and what life is like there.

**RE:** Children will continue their learning about why Christians call Jesus the 'Saviour' and 'Rescuer'.

**Science:** Children will be learning to observe and measure growth in humans.

**PSHE:** Children will continue the module 'Rights and responsibilities'.

**Computing:** Children will continue their computing module called 'Effective searching: spreadsheets'.

**DT:** Children will continue their DT module for this half term, which is called 'Mechanism: Fairground Wheel'.

**Music:** We will continue the music module for this half term, which is called 'Singing: Theme is on this Island'.

**PE:** For this half term, the children will be participating in Dance.

Please find inside your child's homework book, common exception word handwriting practise. Work through the words at your child's pace and practise any words that your child is struggling to spell.
