Maths

This week the children will be revisiting position and direction using key vocabulary to describe where things are.

English

To develop the next part of our fables, we will be exploring noun phrases (e.g. my dog/some tables) and expanded noun phrases (e.g. a dark sky/ those happy children) to help make our writing more interesting.

Phonics and Reading

In phonics the children won't be learning any new graphemes, we will spend time revisiting and consolidating all of the sounds we have covered this academic year and all of the tricky words

Topic

Geography - We will be learning about physical and natural features of Wales this week and comparing them to England and Scotland.

Science- Our next Science through stories lesson will focus on materials and involve the children building an animal home & waterproof testing!

RE - We will be exploring the question: How do Christians, Jews and Muslims try to copy God's love for the world?

Music - the children will be learning to interpret symbols to demonstrate a pitch pattern.

PSHE- This week Milo will remind us of all the different ways we can use our money. We will play a game to explore the options and share our thoughts.

Computing - We will be learning to find and understand examples of where technology is used in the local community.

PE- We will be continuing our learning in the units: target games and athletics.
