Maths

Learning in school:

In maths, children will continue their learning on money:

- Count money pounds and pence
- Choose notes and coins
- Make the same amount
- Compare amounts of money

English, Reading & Fluency

Learning in school:

In English, the children will continue to write their story books. After each page of their story book, children will then go back and edit using the 'editing pencil' as a visual prompt to remind children to include:

- punctuation - capital letters/full stops/exclamation sentences/commas for lists/question marks
- crack open boring words - can you choose any other interesting adjectives to make it more exciting?
- Have you used simple and multi clause sentences? - using different conjunctions not just 'and'
- Can you add any adverbs? Describe one of your verbs (doing words)

Reading:

Children will start to read 'The Speediest Sloth'. Children will be focusing on the VIPERS: vocabulary and prediction.

Fluency:

This week, we will look at a speech on women's suffrage.

Please continue to read at home and upload your comments onto the 'BoomReader' app.

SPAG

Learning in school:

Children will be reviewing Phase 5 phonemes, graphemes and tricky words. They will practise reading, writing and spelling using these graphemes.

Topic

Learning in school:

History: Children will be learning about what Emily Davison was fighting for and why?

RE: Children will be learning about how some Muslims get ready to talk to Allah and why and how do Muslims show that prayer is very important to them?

Science: children will recognise that seeds and bulbs contain what they need to grow into a plant
