Please see below to find out what is happening next term...

Learning in school:

Theme for the first half of Spring Term: Dangerous Dinosaurs! We are going back in time to widen our knowledge about dinosaurs. We will be looking at the similarities and differences between the dinosaurs, their size and features. We will also be learning facts using non-fiction books and learning how to look after dinosaurs

Theme for the Week: Shhh, it is a surprise!

We will be having a surprise delivery, and the children will be discussing what it could be and what might it reveal...

The children will be writing their own imaginary holiday stories where their "who" character will go on an adventure "where" and "what doing". We will also be exploring nouns (who) and starting to write a book, initially with "who" and a drawing. We will be discussing things are safe or unsafe for our bodies, including medicines.

Phonics

This week we will be re-capping the digraphs we have learned previously (qu, ch, sh, th, ng, nk) and learning the new digraphs ai, ee and oa as well as our first trigraph igh. We will send out sounds sheet the first week back.

Maths:

On our first week back we will be recapping numbers 1 to 5 and introducing 0. We will be using stories to support our learning, exploring number lines and counting frames, and practising subitising (recognising numbers of objects to 5 without the need to count).
