Maths

In maths this week will continue learning subtraction (taking away) from a whole number using the story structure first... then... and now and introducing subtraction on a number line.

English

This week we are ready to publish our very own picture books! The children will have the opportunity to edit their own work by introducing adjectives and also making sure the have included the product goals of a good picture book.

Phonics

In Phonics we will be learning the sounds e-e (like in athlete) ew (oo like in grew and yoo like in few), ie (ee like in shield) ,aw (or like in claw).

Reading

In this story Carl is an artist who paints landscapes from around the world. He uses a range of techniques and styles to bring his pictures to life...so much so that he is transported there! In Fluency we will be learning The Paintbox by Jean Kenward. With a focus on: Rhythm

Topic

Absorbing is the theme around this weeks science, learning about the type of materials that will absorb water and what will not.

In Art we will be using Lego bricks to print a pattern or picture. The children will create a printing block to use and overlap and offset primary-coloured paints and discuss the results.

In RE we will be exploring the story of the birth of Jesus and Why we celebrate Christmas.

PE

In Fundamentals the children will be learning about changing direction and dodging. They will need to listen carefully to instructions and practise moving safely.
