### **Maths**

In Maths, we will be continuing our learning about place value within 100. We have previously encountered number lines to 10, 20 and 50. We will use our knowledge of counting to and from 100 in 1s and 10s, to label numberlines with different starting and ending points. We will then explore finding one more and one less of a given number within 100. We will be thinking about how we find one more and one less of a number when it is a multiple of ten. Following this, we will be comparing numbers using the language 'greater than' 'less than' and 'equal to'.

### **English**

In English our new writing project will be fables. We will spend lots of time reading and dissecting what makes a fable a fable! For example, they usually have animal characters with a clear characteristic and they have a moral/ lesson to be learnt. If you have any fables at home please share them with your child/ren or they could bring them into class.
