Maths

Learning in school:

In maths, children will complete their learning on statistics and begin their learning on position and direction:

- Interpret pictograms 2, 5 and 10
- End of unit assessment for statistics and beginning of unit assessment for position and direction.

English, Reading & Fluency

Learning in school:

In English, children will begin writing their story. We will be writing chapter 1 focusing on character descriptions and setting descriptions and chapter 2 will introduce the 'big' problem. We will be using expanded noun phrases, similes, adverbs and conjunctions to enhance our writing.

Reading:

The children will be completing reading quiz papers.

Fluency:

This week, we will be looking at a poem called 'My treasures'.

Learning in school:

Children will be reviewing Phase 5 phonemes, graphemes and tricky words. They will practise reading, writing and spelling using these graphemes.
