### **Maths**

#### **Learning in school:**

In maths, children will finish their learning on length and height and begin their learning on mass, capacity and temperature:

- Four operations with mass
- Compare volume and capacity
- Measure in millilitres
- Measure in litres

### **English, Reading & Fluency**

#### **Learning in school:**

In English, children will be creating a front cover, contents page and glossary for their non-fiction texts. Children will then make additions, revisions and corrections to their writing using a bookmark checklist.

#### **Guided Reading:**

Children will continue reading the focus text: 'The Water Drop'. Children will be focusing on the VIPERS: vocabulary and inference.

#### **Fluency:**

This week, we will look at a poem called 'Springtime Magic'.

**Please continue to read at home and record it in the yellow 'Home Reading Diary'.**

### **SPAG**

#### **Learning in school:**

Children will be reviewing Phase 5 phonemes, graphemes and tricky words. They will practise reading, writing and spelling using these graphemes.

#### **Learning in school:**

**Geography:** Children will be learning what an aerial view is and observing different aerial photographs.

**RE:** Children will be learning about if there is a rescue at Easter.

**Science:** Children will be learning to recognise the importance of exercise and personal hygiene.

**PSHE:** Children will continue the module 'Rights and responsibilities'.

**Computing:** Children will continue their computing module called 'Spreadsheets'.
