Maths

In Maths we will finishing off place value to 50 and beginning our next block of learning 'Length'. This week the children will be also taking part in NFERs.

English

In week 3 of our non fiction writing we will be adding questions and editing. We will be focusing on making sure our writing has conjunctions, capital letters and the correct punctuation.

Phonics and Reading

Our new graphemes will be: a (or) water, a (o) want, grow the code: (air) ear, ere
There will be no new tricky words this week. We will be revising the words: **who, whole, because, eye, people thought, through**

In line with British Science Week our fluency text is an AI speech called: Dreaming Big: I want to be a Scientist!

Topic

In our weekly science lesson where we will be learning about garden and wild plants, we will also be: smashing stereotypes, learning about STEM jobs, using our close observations skills, discussing scientific questions and sharing books with a science theme.

History- In history we will be exploring the question: Did everyone live like Queen Victoria? We will be learning about rich and poor life in the Victorian era.

PSHE- We will be thinking about the importance of taking care of things.

RE- We will be exploring stories Jesus told and looking at what Christians learn from his stories.

Music- We will be creating rhythmic patterns with instruments by identifying the syllables in given words and phrases.

Additional notes and reminders

This week the children will be taking part in NFER assessments. They will take place on different days in the week and our way of assessing the children's learning so far. They are nothing to worry about and will help inform our planning moving forward.
