## Maths

### Learning in school:

In maths, children will begin their learning on multiplication and division:

- Divide by two
- Doubling and halving
- Odd and even numbers
- The 10 times table

## English, Reading & Fluency

### Learning in school:

In English, children will be sorting fiction and non-fiction and looking at the key features in the texts. Children will then be choosing the topic that they are interested in and they will create a topic tree using different sub-headings.

### Reading:

It will be individual reads this week. Please make sure your child's book is in their book bag.

### Fluency:

This week, we will look at a poem called 'Upside down poem'.

**Please continue to read at home and record it in the yellow 'Home Reading Diary'.**

### Learning in school:

Children will be reviewing Phase 5 phonemes, graphemes and tricky words. They will practise reading, writing and spelling using these graphemes.

## Learning in school:

**Geography:** Children will be learning about where the hottest places on Earth are.

**Science:** Children will be learning to identify different stages of the human lifecycle.
