Maths

Learning in school:

In maths, children will begin their learning on fractions:

- Find the whole
- Unit fractions
- Non-unit fractions
- Recognise the equivalence of a half and two-quarters

English, Reading & Fluency

Learning in school:

In English, children will start to read 'Nellie Choc-ice, Penguin explorer'. We are going to explore key features of a chapter book and explore that they can have big problems and mini problems in one story.
