Happy half term break to everyone! We look forward to seeing you all again on Monday 01.06.26.

Maths

When we return, we will be thinking about place value from 50 to 100. The children will be extending their knowledge of multiples of 10. They will be given a range of different practical experiences where they can explore counting by grouping in tens and counting by leaving items as ones. The children will be partitioning using concrete resources and then abstract numbers and other representations such as part-whole models.

English

This week the children will start to write their instructions. We will be focussing on the key features: time words and 'bossy' verbs and adjectives and adverbs to add detail..

Phonics and Reading

This week we will be 'growing the code':
/ai/ eigh (eight), aigh (straight), ey (grey), ea (break)
/ear/ ere (here), eer (deer)
/n/ kn (knee), gn (gnaw)
/m/ mb (thumb)

Our tricky words are: **our, their, two, busy, beautiful, pretty, hour**

This week we will be reading 1:1 with the children. Please make sure your child has their reading book in their bag each day.

Topic

Our topic next half term will be 'Travel and Tales' linking our fables work in English with our Geography work on countries in the UK.

DT- The children will be constructing a moving windmill.

In RE we will be exploring: What makes the world precious?

PSHE- We will be continue to speak about staying healthy and spreading germs.

Science this term, will give the children the opportunity to revise previous knowledge learned this year while developing their working scientifically skills.

PE- Our new units is: Invasion games

In computing we will be learning about spreadsheets.

Additional notes and reminders

Over half term, we would like you to focus on phonics revision and reading. The phonics screening is the week beginning 8th June 2026, so we would like them to access some phonics during their week away from school.

We hope that next half term will bring good weather so when it does please apply sun cream before your child comes to school and provide them with a named sunhat and water bottle.
