### **Maths**

#### **Learning in school:**

In maths, children will finish their learning on length and height and begin their learning on mass, capacity and temperature:

- Four operations with lengths and heights
- Compare mass
- Measure in grams

### **English, Reading & Fluency**

#### **Learning in school:**

In English, children will continue to write their non-fiction text focusing on noun phrases, possessive apostrophes and conjunctions. Children will also be introduced to Exclamation sentences.

#### **Guided Reading:**

Children will read 'The Water Drop'. Children will be focusing on the VIPERS: vocabulary.

#### **Fluency:**

This week, we will look at a poem called 'Crayon'.

**Please continue to read at home and record it in the yellow 'Home Reading Diary'.**

### **SPAG**

#### **Learning in school:**

Children will be reviewing Phase 5 phonemes, graphemes and tricky words. They will practise reading, writing and spelling using these graphemes.

### **Topic**

#### **Learning in school:**

**Geography:** Children will be learning to compare rural Malawi and Stoneleigh.

**RE:** Children will continue their learning about why Christians call Jesus the 'Saviour' and 'Rescuer'.

**Science:** Children will be learning to identify and list the basic needs for survival for humans and animals.

**PSHE:** Children will continue the module 'Rights and responsibilities'.

**Computing:** Children will continue their computing module called 'Effective searching: spreadsheets'.

**DT:** Children will continue their DT module for this half term, which is called 'Mechanism: Fairground Wheel'.

**Music:** We will continue the music module for this half term, which is called 'Singing: Theme is on this Island'.

**PE:** For this half term, the children will be participating in Dance.
