Maths

Learning in school:

In maths, children will begin their learning on statistics:

- Make tally charts
- Make tables

Learning in school:

Children will be reviewing Phase 5 phonemes, graphemes and tricky words. They will practise reading, writing and spelling using these graphemes.

Topic

Learning in school:

This week is BET's Sustainability week. Each day is dedicated to a different theme of sustainability:

Meat free Monday
Technology Tuesday
Wildlife Wednesday
Thrifty Thursday
Feel Good Friday!

For Meat free Monday, children will learn about why meat is harmful for the environment. They will design a healthy meal and focus on what protein could be used instead of meat.

For Wildlife Wednesday, children will understand what it means for an animal to be endangered and explore how human actions affect habitats, especially the polar regions. They will express ideas about protecting the planet through writing.

For Feel Good Friday, children will create a poster about how they can be 'green' at home.

RE: Children will be looking at giving and receiving and how they give and receive.

DT: Children will continue their new module called 'Making a moving monster'.

PSHE: Children will continue their new module 'Growing and changing'.

Music: Children will continue their new music module for this half term, which is called 'Musical me'.

Computing: Children will continue their new computing module 'Coding'.

PE: For this half term, the children will be doing 'Invasion'.
