Maths

Learning in school:

In maths, children will continue their learning on fractions:

English, Reading & Fluency

Learning in school:

In English, the children will be exploring key features of a chapter book. The children will be sharing their favourite chapter books with their friends, and they will be coming up with ideas for their own characters in their chapter book.

Reading:

Fluency:
