Maths

We will begin our unit on multiplication and division. We will start by identifying equal groups and then revisit counting in tens and then practise counting in 2's and 5's.

English

This week we will be writing a poem using our senses in an animal habitat focusing on what you can see and hear. The children have really enjoyed writing poems and are excited to complete their books.

Phonics and Reading

We are revising the graphemes that make a long 'igh' sound: ie, i-e and the graphemes that make the long 'oa' sound: o, o-e.

We will be revising the tricky words: **were one says here today**

Topic

Science - The children will be exploring senses, taking part in different activities and discussing what senses they used.

PSHE- Eat well- the children will be learning about the importance of a balanced diet and evaluating lunchboxes.

RE- We will be thinking about how our activities during the week tend to be different to our activities at the weekend. We will then start exploring 'Why could it be important for some Jewish families to do something different during Shabbat?'

Music- Now we can identify high and low pitch sounds we will be making pitch patterns to create our own superhero theme tune.

Please note that as the week progresses it is sometimes necessary to change what is planned to meet the learning needs of the children and therefore changes to the above may occur.

Additional notes and reminders

Homework - Each week this half term children will be sent home homework to support them with the phonics screening test that they will take part in the week of 8th June. For more information you can visit the DFE website.

Brooklands - On Monday we will be talking to the children about our trip, going over the plan for the day and behaviours we expect to see. We are looking forward to a nice day out. If you have any questions or concerns please contact your class teacher asap.

Loan a lamb - This week we are fortunate enough to have lambs on our school field. The children will be taken out in groups to see them and have an opportunity to feed them too. Again if you have any concerns please discuss this with the class teacher.
