Maths

In Maths this week we will be learning about time. We will explore using different vocabulary related to time throughout the week. First, we will describe our own routine and use "before", "after", "first", "next" and "finally" to describe sort and order events. We will learn the sequence of the days in a week and know that there are 7 days that repeat in a cycle. We will then explore the sequence of the months of the year and begin to learn the number of days in each month.

English

This week the children will start to write their instructions. We will be focussing on the key features: time words and 'bossy' verbs and adjectives and adverbs to add detail.

Phonics and Reading

We are revising the graphemes:

'i' in tiger

'a' paper

'ow' snow

'u' unicorn

We will be revising the tricky words: **two, eye, thought, through, friend.**

This week we will be doing one to one reads with the children. Please remember their book bags everyday with their reading record and their current reading book.

Topic

History- This week we will be comparing early flight to present flight. We will be exploring and analysing resources to help us answer the question: How has flight changed since the Wright Brothers?

Art- Thank you for all the shoe boxes! This week the children will be making their box into a loom by wrapping it in string. They will then create a piece of woven art by weaving wool and ribbon through it and attaching plaits and knotted material.

PSHE- We will be passing on the praise. Celebrating others achievements.

Music- For our final session in this unit, we will be performing our superhero theme tunes.
