Maths

In Maths we will be looking at subtraction. We will practise counting back and explore 'counting up' to find the difference. We will be looking at the skills required to answer missing number problems. We will think carefully about whether a part is missing or a whole is missing. We will apply our skills of subtraction and addition to find the missing numbers. Then we will be revisiting fact families and finding all related facts when working with numbers within 20.

English

In English, we will begin our non-fiction topic. Reading as writers and explore different types of non-fiction text to magpie ideas to use in our own non-fiction book about what the children are experts in.

Phonics and Reading

There won't be any new graphemes this week as we consolidate all the phonemes covered this half term. Each class will focus on their own identified set of trickiest sounds for them. They will be identifying the graphemes individually as well as spotting them and blending them in real and 'alien' (pseudo) words. We will also be reading 1:1 so please make sure your child's reading book is in their bag. We will also be practising fluency with the AI generated poem: Feelings journey.

Topic

PSHE -This year's theme for Children's Mental Health Week is 'This is My Place', focusing on the importance of belonging for positive mental health. Across the Mead and Auriol, we will be completing a range of activities throughout the week to celebrate 'belonging'- belonging to our class, our school and the wider community.

At the end of the week, on Friday 13th February, children are invited to 'Come as Yourself' and wear clothing which celebrates who they are.
